Resolution relative to application for an Expanding Public Access to Technology Grant. (Library)
This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Public Library to apply for a Grant from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, in the amount of \$67,951 with a city share of \$1,401 and a grantor share of \$66,550. The purpose of the project is to provide computer hardware to equip community training centers at Atkinson, East, Finney, Mill Road and Villard Avenue neighborhood libraries.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 12/01/99 to 06/30/00 would cost \$67,951 of which \$1,401(2%) would be provided by the city and \$66,550(98%) would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation is authorized.
