Whereas, It has been proposed by the Department of City Development that the unimproved alley in the block bounded by West Howard Avenue, West Norwich Street, South 5th Place and South 6th Street, be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 62.73, Wisconsin Statutes; now, therefore, be it
