This resolution will approve a final plat that provides 14 lots for single-family development, an outlot for storm water management and dedicates land for public streets. Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the final plat of the Mayberry Subdivision, being a redivision of Parcel 2 of Certified Survey Map No. 2787, and Parcels 1 and 4 of Certified Survey Map No. 7145 and unplatted lands, located in part of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 16, Town 6 North, Range 21 East, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin; having been approved by the City Plan Commission and the Commissioner of Public Works, is approved.
