Resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant. (Health Department)

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, to accept and fund the Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant project from the Medical College of Wisconsin in the amount of \$83,369. The purpose of the project is to assess the effectiveness of HIV risk reduction counseling delivered by a computer.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Medical College of Wisconsin to assess the effectiveness of HIV risk reduction counseling delivered by a computer; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 05/01/04 to 04/30/05 would cost \$83,369 provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Medical College of Wisconsin is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2004 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the project titled Weinhardt Computerized HIV Intervention Grant:
