THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City engineering cost estimated to be \$15,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$67,000.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable. After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council. The City cost for engineering these projects is estimated to be \$15,000 with the total cost estimated to be \$67,000.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

4th Aldermanic District

N. 10th St. - W. Wells St. to a point 200 feet m/l north of W. Wells St. (WT410071087): Relaying water main. (Nonassessable Water Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost including this request is \$67,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2007 construction season.
