Whereas, Plaintiff Michael T. Wilson filed a lawsuit against the City of Milwaukee and certain employees thereof; and

Whereas, The City has agreed to settle the lawsuit for the amount of \$35,000; and

Whereas, The City Attorney recommends and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee deems it expeditious and just to pay this claim; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that proper city officers be and hereby are authorized and directed to issue a City check totaling the amount of \$35,000., payable to the order of Bornstein Law Offices, S.C.
