Resolution to cancel personal property taxes levied against Miller Compressing, 1640 West Bruce Street, for the year 2000, plus interest applicable to date of repayment, if appropriate. (Assessor's Office)

This resolution requires the cancellation of erroneous taxes because of a decrease in assessment as made by the Wisconsin Tax Appeals Commission of the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, the issuance of a check to the City Treasurer or taxpayer as applicable, and the proper reductions of State Tax Credits by journal entries.

Whereas, An original equated value assessment in the amount of \$3,226,200 (Machinery & Equipment: \$1,814,700, Furniture & Fixtures: \$1,354,900, All Other: \$56,600) was made against the personal property known as Account No. 8640-5303, for the year 2000; and

Whereas, The Wisconsin Tax Appeals Commission of the Wisconsin Department of Revenue has decreased this assessment to \$2,421,600, (Machinery & Equipment: \$1,814,700, Furniture & Fixtures: \$550,300, All Other: \$56,600) for a reduction of \$804,600; now, therefore, be it
