An ordinance relating to budgeting and accounting procedures for grant projects and programs. 304-81-7-d-2 am

This ordinance amends the code to require the department administering a grant to request additional authorization from the budget and management division in accordance with s. 18-10-6 of the charter if expenditures charged to a major street and bridge improvement grant exceed the amount authorized for city share by 10% of the total cost or \$5,000, whichever is greater, but limited to \$150,000.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1 Section 304-81-7-d-2 of the code is amended to read:

304-81. Grants Projects and Programs.

7. BUDGET MODIFICATIONS AND COST OVERRUNS AND DISALLOWED COSTS. d-2. If expenditures charged to a major street and bridge improvement grant exceed the amount authorized for city share by

10% of the total cost or \$5,000, whichever is greater, >> but limited to \$150,000, << the administering city department shall request additional authorization from the budget and management division in accordance with s. 18-10-6 of the city charter. The city comptroller is authorized and directed to make the approved transfers.
