THE CHAIR

Resolution directing the Department of City Development to prepare a resolution to vacate approximately 340 feet of East Reservoir Avenue Extended, located East of North Hubbard Avenue, in the 6th Aldermanic District. (DCD)

- Analysis -

This resolution directs the Department of City Development to prepare a resolution which vacates the above portion of public street in accordance with vacation proceedings under power granted to the City of Milwaukee by Section 66.297(1), Wisconsin Statutes, and Section 81-308-28, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. This vacation is necessary for the Redevelopment Authority to sell the adjacent property for mixed-use development.

Whereas, It has been proposed by the Redevelopment Authority that approximately 340 feet of East Reservoir Avenue Extended, located East of North Hubbard Avenue, be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.297, Wisconsin Statutes; and

Whereas, The vacation of this portion of street is necessary so that the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee can sell the land to be used for mixed-use development; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the Department of City Development is directed to prepare a resolution to vacate the subject portion of street in accordance with Section 81-308-28 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
