Substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Grant from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund a Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Grant project from the Center for Disease Control through the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services in the amount of \$658,993. The purpose of the project is to support comprehensive and coordinated service delivery to lead-poisoned children.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services for comprehensive and coordinated service delivery to lead-poisoned children; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 07/01/07 to 06/30/08 would cost \$658,993 provided by the

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it
