An ordinance relating to the license periods for Class "B" special alcohol beverage licenses.

Currently, the city code does not specify who is responsible for setting the license period when a Class "B" special alcohol beverage license is issued. This ordinance provides that a Class B" special license shall be issued by the city clerk for a period of time set by the local common council member not to exceed 14 consecutive days.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 90-4-7-f-0 of the code is repealed and recreated to read:

90-4. Classification of Licenses.

7. CLASS "B" SPECIAL LICENSE. (A SHORT-TERM LICENSE FOR CLUBS.).

f. Objections.

Part 2. Section 90-4-7-g of the code is amended to read:

g. Issuance. If no written objection has been filed and upon payment of the license fee specified in s. 81-28, the city clerk shall issue the Class "B" special license >>for a period of time set by the local

common council member not to exceed 14 consecutive days<< .
