Resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of an Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) grant. (Police Department)

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for, accept and fund an Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation, in the amount of \$15,226 with a city share of \$7,226 and a grantor share of \$8,000. The purpose of this grant is to assist in specified OCDETF investigations and prosecutions.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 10/01/02 to 09/30/03 would cost \$15,226 of which \$7,226 (47%) would be provided by the city and \$8,000 (53%) would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation is authorized and that the Police Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 940843; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

 Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2002 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects, the following amount for the program titled: Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force:
