Resolution granting permission to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to keep and maintain three groundwater monitoring wells in West Pierce Street, near 1333 West Pierce Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District in the City of Milwaukee. (Infrastructure Services Division)
- Analysis -

Resolution granting permission to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to keep and maintain three groundwater monitoring wells in the public right-of-way of West Pierce Street, in the vicinity of 1333 West Pierce Street.

Whereas, It has been deemed necessary to conduct an environmental assessment for a site located at 1333 West Pierce Street to determine chemical product migrational patterns; and

Whereas, It has been determined that, in addition to the proposed monitoring wells needed to be placed on private property, three locations need to be located within the public right-of-way for extended periods of time; and

Whereas, These three monitoring wells may only legally remain in the public right-of-way by the Common Council granting approval; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, 2300 North Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, P.O. Box 12436, Milwaukee, WI 53212-0436 is hereby granted the following permission:

To place, keep and/or maintain three flush-mounted monitoring wells in the vicinity of 1333 West Pierce Street located as follows: three monitoring wells are or are proposed to be located in the south sidewalk area of West Pierce Street, approximately 5 feet north of the southline of West Pierce Street and 250, 390 and 552 feet west of the westline of North 12th Street.

These monitoring wells shall be maintained and used/removed to the satisfaction of the Departments of Public Works in accordance with the City of Milwaukee Codes and DPW specifications and rules. All necessary permits shall be obtained from the City of Milwaukee; and, be it

Further Resolved, That this permission is granted only on the condition that the WDNR shall:

1. Hold the City of Milwaukee or its agents harmless and accept responsibility for any and all liabilities that may arise through implementation of the permission granted herein.
2. Obtain the necessary Department of Public Works permit prior to installation of the monitoring wells and any other related items within the right-of-way.
3. Install the monitoring wells as shown on the plan with "as-built" plans submitted to the City Engineer to show the actual installation.
4. Whenever the monitoring wells are no longer needed or when so ordered for public necessity, not only remove these items but shall also restore to its former condition and to the approval of the Commissioner of Public Works any public improvement which was removed, changed or disturbed by reason of the granting of this resolution. Grantee shall not be entitled to any damages for such removal.
