Substitute resolution approving construction of nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City construction cost estimated to be \$156,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$185,000.

This resolution directs the installation and construction of certain public improvements which have been determined to be nonassessable by the Commissioner of Public Works. The City cost of the projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$156,000. The total estimated cost of these projects is \$185,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct nonassessable improvements; and

Whereas, Plans, specifications and cost estimates have been prepared for the following described improvements:

4th Aldermanic District

Marquette University Pedestrian Crossings (ST211140185) File Number 140974: Removing and replacing curb and gutter and crosswalk as necessary. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$4,000, Additional Funds). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$27,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

City Wide

2017 Sanitary Manhole Inspection Project (SM494160203) File Number 161022: (Infiltration/Inflow Reduction Fund -- \$120,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$125,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

2017 Sewer Structures Inspection Project (SM495160021) File Number 161022: (Infiltration/Inflow Reduction Fund -- \$32,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$33,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.
