040671 Substitute 1 030414 THE CHAIR

Substitute ordinance to further amend the 2004 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council (District Council #48, Association of Scientific Personnel & TEAM). The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 3 of ordinance File Number 030414 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 1, 2003 - December 22, 2002):

Under Pay Range 205, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$986.40, 1,054.11, 1,097.60, 1,120.48, 1,143.35, 1,166.16 and 1,204.02.

Part 2. Section 4 of ordinance File Number 030414 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 1, 2003 - December 22, 2002):

Under Pay Range 329, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,089.93, 1,164.51, 1,188.08, 1,214.62 and 1,254.42.

Part 3. Section 5 of ordinance File Number 030414 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 1, 2003 - December 22, 2002):

Under Pay Range 400, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$825.87, 889.47, 926.00, 943.17, 961.68, 981.73, 1,001.72 and 1,033.55.

Under Pay Range 404, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$871.73, 935.34, 974.22, 991.35, 1,009.96, 1,029.96, 1,050.00 and 1,081.77.

Under Pay Range 410, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$958.77, 980.57, 1,021.68, 1,044.58, 1,067.47, 1,090.29 and 1,128.16. In addition, above employees eligible for the Clerical Merit Increment shall be paid \$1,151.68 biweekly.

Under Pay Range 415, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,007.36, 1,026.46,

1,069.91, 1,092.83, 1,115.65, 1,138.50 and 1,176.34. In addition, above employees eligible for the Clerical Merit Increment shall be paid \$1,199.94 biweekly.

Under Pay Range 425, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,090.29, 1,116.31, 1,139.83, 1,166.33 and 1,206.15. In addition, above employees eligible for the Clerical Merit Increment shall be paid \$1,235.62 or \$1,266.52 biweekly.

Under Pay Range 435, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,138.50, 1,164.51, 1,188.08, 1,214.62 and 1,254.42. In addition, above employees eligible for the Clerical Merit Increment shall be paid \$1,283.79 or \$1,314.74 biweekly.

Under Pay Range 437, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,108.17, 1,132.38, 1,159.94, 1,184.99, 1,213.15, 1,242.80 and 1,273.96.

Under Pay Range 445, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,188.08, 1,214.62. 1,242.57, 1,271.95 and 1,314.74. In addition, above employees eligible for the Clerical Merit Increment shall be paid \$1,347.80, \$1,385.31, or \$1,425.50 biweekly.

Under Pay Range 450, add the following paragraph: "Employees not represented by a certified collective bargaining unit shall be paid the following biweekly rates effective Pay Period 1, 2002: \$1,159.94, 1,184.99, 1,213.15, 1,242.80, 1,273.96, 1,306.78 and 1,341.84.

The provisions of all other parts of this ordinance are deemed to be in force and effect from and after the first day of the first pay period following passage and publication.

Part 14. This ordinance will take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
