Substitute resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the Public Health 706 Teaching Grant from the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept and fund the Public Health 706 Grant from the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health in the amount of \$7,500 provided by the grantor. The purpose of the grant is to strengthen the relationship of the City of Milwaukee Health Department and the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Public Health 706 Grant from the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 8/18/14 to 01/01/15 would cost \$7,500 provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2014 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Funds, the following amount for the project titled Public Health 706 Grant:

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund - Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Grant Levels; budget

1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
2. Expend from the 2014 grant budget funds for training and out-of-town travel by departmental staff;
3. Enter into leases and subcontracts as detailed in the grant budget; and
4. Expend from the 2014 grant funds for equipment as deemed necessary for program operation.
