test" app	inance prohibits the use of 2 tests that are done on animals to determine the irritancy level of a substance. The "Draize eye irritancy blies a substance to the eyes of unanesthetized animals. The "skin irritancy test" applies a substance to the shaved, abraded skin of hetized animals. The ordinance prohibits both tests on vertebrate animals unless required by state or federal law.
The ordi	nance is enforceable by humane officers. Individuals may file written reports of violations with a humane officer, who must promptly ate.
Violators The May	s of the ordinance are subject to a Class F penalty of a forfeiture of \$50 to \$500. or and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:
Part 1. S	Section 78-31-5 of the code is renumbered to 78-31-6.
Part 2. S	Section 78-31-5 of the code is created to read:
78-31.	Cruelty to Animals.
5.	ANIMAL TESTING. a. In this subsection:
a-1.	"Animal" means a vertebrate nonhuman animal.
a-2. unanestl	"Draize eye irritancy test" means a test to determine the irritancy level of a substance by applying it to the eyes of immobilized, hetized live animals, generally rabbits.
a-3. unanestl	"Skin irritancy test" means a test to determine the irritancy level of a substance by applying it to the shaved, abraded skin of hetized animals, generally rabbits.
a-4.	"Testing" means a procedure involving the administration of a substance to determine its relative irritation or toxicity.
b. irritancy	Except as otherwise required by state or federal law, no person shall engage in any animal testing that involves use of the Draize eye test or the skin irritancy test.
other releason to subsection	An individual who believes that this subsection is being violated may file with a humane officer a written report specifying the location blation, the approximate date and time of the violation, if known, the name of the person perpetrating the violation, if known, and any evant information that may assist the humane officer's investigation. Whenever a humane officer receives such a report or has other o suspect a violation of this subsection, the humane officer shall promptly investigate to determine whether a violation of this on has occurred.
