THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City engineering cost estimated to be \$80,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$215,000.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable. After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council. The City cost for engineering these projects is estimated to be \$80,000 with the total cost estimated to be \$215,000.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

3rd Aldermanic District

Cherry Street Bascule Bridge (BR100060104): Bridge repairs and repairs to the northwest retaining wall. (City Share Non-assessable Structure Fund -- \$50,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$50,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2006/2007 construction season.

4th Aldermanic District

W. McKinley Bl. - N. 27th St. to N. 35th St. (ST211060181): Install traffic calming speed humps. The total estimated cost for this project is \$15,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2006 construction season.

12th Aldermanic District

W. Scott St. - S. 4th St. to S. 6th St. (WT410061064): Installing butterfly valve. (Nonassessable Water Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$40,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the spring of 2007 construction season.

15th Aldermanic District

N. 24th St. - W. North Ave. to W. Medford Ave. (WT410061063): Relaying water main. (Nonassessable Water Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$110,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the fall of 2006 construction season.

Further Resolved, That all City Departments are authorized to perform engineering, surveys, plan preparation, and determine an estimated cost thereof; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
