Under this ordinance, this maximum annual household income will be increased to \$25,000. This amount was last changed in 2004, from \$17,000 to \$20,000. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows: Part 1. Section 115-44-3-b of the code is amended to read: 115-44. Deferred Special Assessments. 3. ELIGIBILITY. b.
