THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the 2024-2025 Public Health Emergency Preparedness grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services.

Substitute resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept, and fund the 2024-2025 Public Health Emergency Preparedness grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services in the amount of \$543,099 with a City share of \$0 and a grantor share of \$543,099. The funding will provide training, supplies, equipment, and services to assure the Health Department is ready to respond to various emergency situations.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services to assure the Health Department is ready to respond to various emergency situations; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant program from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025 will cost \$543,099 comprised of \$543,099, or 100%, grantor share and \$0, or 0%, City share; now, therefore, be it;

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, that the Commissioner of Health or their designee is authorized to execute the grant agreement for these funds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant parent account of the 2024 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the project titled Public Health Preparedness 2024-2025:

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Levels; budget to these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement; and be it

- 1. Expend from the amount appropriated sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Expend from the 2024 grant budget funds for specific items of equipment; and,
- 3. Expend from the 2024 grant budget funds for training and out-of-town travel by departmental staff; and, be it
