Resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Click It - Why Risk It 2002/2003 grant. (Police Department)

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for, accept and fund a Click It - Why Risk It project grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, in the amount of \$11,613 with a city share of \$3,613 and a grantor share of \$8,000. The purpose of the project is the enforcement of safety belt/safety seat usage, and speeding and driving impaired enforcement.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for a Click It - Why Risk It project, and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 11/01/02 to 04/30/03 would cost \$11,613 of which \$3,613 (31%) would be provided by the city and \$8,000 (69%) would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety is authorized and that the Police Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 940843; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2002 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects, the following amount for the program titled: Click It - Why Risk It 2002/2003 Program Grant:

- 2. Create the necessary Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project/Grant levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amount required under the grant agreement;

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted for the Milwaukee Police Department which is authorized to:

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Transfer funds within the project budget as long as the amount expended for each specific purpose does not exceed the amount authorized by the budget by 10 percent; and
