Substitute resolution approving construction of nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City construction cost estimated to be \$6,643,409.26 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$8,778,674.35.

This resolution directs the installation and construction of certain public improvements which have been determined to be nonassessable by the Commissioner of Public Works. The City cost of the projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$6,643,409.26. The total estimated cost of these projects is \$8,778,674.35.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct nonassessable improvements; and

Whereas, Plans, specifications and cost estimates have been prepared for the following described improvements:

4th Aldermanic District

Alley betw. W. Clybourn St., W. St Paul Av., N. 28th St., N. 29th St. (new e/w leg to N. 29th St.) (MKE playground)(ST212180117) File Number 190519: Concrete alley construction. (Nonassessable Alley paving fund -- \$10,000 additional funds) This project was completed in 2020 and the funds are needed to close out the contract.

6th Aldermanic District

W. Capitol Dr. - N. 10th St. to N. 16th St. (WT410210901) File Number 211199: Water main joint repair. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$0; Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$300,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$325,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2021 construction season.

5th and 9th Aldermanic Districts

W. Calumet Road - Bridge over the Little Menomonee River (BR3201809XX/ST3201809XX) (2984-50-70) File Number 181112: Bridge replacement and approach roadways. This project is anticipated to be constructed in the 2022 construction season.

This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction season.

W. Oklahoma Ave. - S. 76th St. to S. 84th St. (WT410190501) File Number 181686: Water main extension. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$0; Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$3,645,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$3,680,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction season.

W. Oklahoma Ave. - S. 84th St. to S. 100th St. (WT410190502) File Number 181686: Water main extension. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$0; Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$35,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$50,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction season.
