THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City engineering cost estimated to be \$184,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$2,103,000.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable. After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council. The City cost for engineering these projects is estimated to be \$184,000 with the total cost estimated to be \$2,103,000.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

2nd Aldermanic District

W. Thurston Ave. - N. 94th St. to N. 97th St. (ST211130200): Pedestrian walkway. Laying concrete walk. Doing all necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$5,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$20,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

3rd Aldermanic District

N. Maryland Ave. - E. Kenwood Blvd. to E. Hartford Ave. (SM495130048): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$144,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

6th Aldermanic District

E. Locust St. - N. Holton St. to N. Pierce St. (SM495130046): Relaying combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$235,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

N. 18th St. - 125 feet m/l north of W. Chambers St. to W. Hopkins St. (SM495130047): Relaying combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$61,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

7th Aldermanic District

N. 56th St. - W. Parkway Dr. to 155 feet m/l south of W. Hampton Ave. (SM495130044): Sanitary Sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$69,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

8th and 12th Aldermanic Districts

W. Mitchell St. - S. 19th St. to S. 20th St. (SM495130037): Combined large diameter sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$152,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

S. 19th St. - W. Burnham St. to W. Mitchell St. (SM495130036): Combined large diameter sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$229,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

11th Aldermanic District

S. 95th St. - W. Beloit Rd. to 600 feet south of W. Beloit Rd. (WT410140664): Relaying water main. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$7,000; Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$8,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$135,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

12th Aldermanic District

S. 17th St. - S. Pearl St. to 200 feet m/l south of S. Pearl St. (SM495130049): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$1,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$15,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

Alley between S. Congo Ave., S. Rogers St. and S. 19th St. (SM495120509): Sewer work prior to paving. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$9,000). The total estimated cost for this project is \$9,000. This project was completed in 2012.

13th Aldermanic District

S. 17th St. - W. Morgan Ave. to W. Ohio Ave. (SM495120524): Sewer work prior to paving. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost for this project is \$25,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

14th Aldermanic District

E. Estes St. - S. Shore Dr. to S. Superior St. (SM495130038): Combined large diameter sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$105,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

15th Aldermanic District

N. 47th St. - W. Clarke St. to W. Center St. (SM495130045): Relaying combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$154,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

Various Aldermanic Districts

High Impact Streets - Asphalt resurface by contract - various locations (ST216130103): Asphalt pavement overlay. (Nonassessable High Impact Streets -- \$5,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$400,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.

City of Franklin

S. 27th St. - 500 feet north of W. College Ave. to W. Sycamore St. (WT410140007): Water main alteration. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$12,000; Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$13,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$350,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

;and, be it

Further Resolved, That all City Departments are authorized to perform engineering, surveys, plan preparation, and determine an estimated cost thereof; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
