Resolution authorizing the application, acceptance and funding of the project Growing Milwaukee funded under the Workforce Investment Act from the U. S. Department of Labor through the Community Development Grants Administration.

This resolution allows the City of Milwaukee to accept the amount of \$381,000 from the U. S. Department of Labor for the project entitled - Growing Milwaukee.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the U. S. Department of Labor for the project Growing Milwaukee in the amount of \$381,000; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 03/01/10 through 02/28/12 would cost \$381,000 which would be provided by the grantor; now therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Community Development Grants Administration shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2010 Special Revenue - Grant and Aid Projects, the following amounts for the project titled: Growing Milwaukee:

2. Create the necessary Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project/Grant levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amount required under the grant agreement; and

3. Establish the necessary City Share Project Values; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted through the Community Development Grants Administration which is authorized to:

1. Expend from the amount budgeted for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;

2. Expend from the 2010 grant budget funds for specific items of equipment;

3. Enter into subcontracts and leases as detailed in the grant budget.
