Substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Refugee Health Screening Grant from the State of Wisconsin - Department of Workforce Development.

- solution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the Refugee Health Screening Grant project from the State of Wisconsin Division of Family and Economic Security (DFES) on behalf of the Department of Children and Families (DCF) in the amount of \$304,500 provided by the grantor. The purpose of the grant is to aid the Tuberculosis Control Clinic in its services to refugees.
- as, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the State of Wisconsin Division of Family and Economic Security (DFES) to aid the Tuberculosis Control Clinic in its services to refugees; and
- as, The operation of this grant project from 10/01/09 to 09/30/10 would cost \$304,500 provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the State of Wisconsin Division of Family and Economic Security (DFES) is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it
