Substitute resolution authorizing the use of the 1999 reprogramming Community Development Block Grant funds as approved by the Policy Committee.

This resolution authorizes the award and use of the 1999 reprogramming Community Development Block Grant funds.

Whereas, The Community Development Policy Committee on May 10, 1999 and on July 12, 1999 approved the funding of activities noted below using the 1999 Community Development Block Grant reprogramming funds; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that these funds are budgeted for the Community Block Grant Administration which is authorized to:

- 1). Expend from the amount appropriated sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date.
- 2). Enter into subrecipient contracts as detailed in the grant budget.; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Community Block Grant Administration is responsible for awarding subrecipient contracts for each of the 1999 approved activities for reprogramming as follows:

Further Resolved, That payments for CDBG costs incurred shall be paid in accordance with approved CDBG reimbursement policy based on the approval by the Community Block Administration and City Comptroller of a Budget Forecast (CDA-51) ; and, be it

Further Resolved, That except as modified by this resolutions, the guidelines for handling the Community Development Block Grant Program set forth in Common Council File Number 74-92-5v are fully applicable to the 1999 Community Development Entitlement Funding Program.
