Resolution directing the Department of City Development to prepare a resolution to vacate North 124th Street between West Hampton Avenue and a point North of West Silver Spring Drive, in the 15th Aldermanic District. (DCD)

- Analysis -

This resolution directs the Department of City Development to prepare a resolution which vacates the above portion of public street in accordance with vacation proceedings under power granted to the City of Milwaukee by Section 66.297(1), Wisconsin Statutes, and Section 81-308-28, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. This vacation is necessary to continue private parking after street improvements have been made. Whereas, It has been proposed by the City of Milwaukee, Department of Public Works, that North 124th Street between West Hampton Avenue and a point North of West Silver Spring Drive be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.297, Wisconsin Statutes; and

Whereas, The vacation of this portion of street is necessary to continue private parking after street improvements have been made; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the Department of City Development is directed to prepare a resolution to vacate the subject portion of street in accordance with Section 81-308-28 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
