Resolution to vacate North 51st Street between West Woolworth Avenue and West Mill Road, in the 9th Aldermanic District. (Department of City Development)

- Analysis -

This resolution vacates the above portion of street in accordance with vacation proceedings under power granted to the City of Milwaukee by Section 66.297(1), Wisconsin Statutes, and Section 81-308-28, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. This vacation is necessary for the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District to remove three culverts so that the creek will flow as an open channel. Whereas, It is proposed that North 51st Street between West Woolworth Avenue and West Mill Road be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.297, Wisconsin Statutes; and

Whereas, This proposed vacation has been reviewed in accordance with Section 81-308-28, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that said portion of street, as indicated by Exhibit "A", is vacated; and, be it

Further Resolved, That as provided by Section 80.32(4), Wisconsin Statutes, such vacation shall not terminate the easements and rights incidental thereto acquired by or belonging to any county, town, village or city, or to any utility or person in any underground structures, improvements or services, as enumerated or otherwise existing in said description of land above described, both easements and rights and all rights of entrance, maintenance, construction and repair of entrance, maintenance, construction and repair with reference thereto shall continue as if said portion of street had not been vacated.
