The City cost of the projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$610,000. The total estimated cost of these projects is \$775,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct nonassessable improvements; and

Whereas, Plans, specifications and cost estimates have been prepared for the following described improvements:

1st Aldermanic District

W. Hampton Ave. - N. Green Bay Ave. to N. Teutonia Ave. (SM493130106) File Number 130953: Bioswales. Best Management Practices (BMP's) for the reduction of TSS in storm water. (Nonassessable TSS Removal Fund -- \$145,000). The total estimated cost for this project including

N. Sherman Blvd. - W. Auer Ave. to W. Congress St. (SM493130107) File Number 130953: Sherman Boulevard bioswales. Best Management Practices (BMP's) for the reduction of TSS in storm water. (Nonassessable TSS Removal Fund -- \$295,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$300,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2014 construction season.

Crackfilling of various streets by contract (ST211130181) File Number 130363: (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$10,000, Additional Funds). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$155,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2013 construction season.
