Currently, the 3100 blocks of S. 18th Street and S. 19th Street are excluded from the Saint Francis Hospital commuter parking impacted area. This ordinance eliminates that exclusion. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 101-27.7-9-c-14 of the code is amended to read:

101-27.7. Residential Daytime Parking Privilege for Commuter Parking Impacted Areas.
