This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept and fund the Intervention to Prevent the Spread of AIDS Grant project from the National Institute for Mental Health through the Medical College of Wisconsin in the amount of \$97,688 grantor share. The purpose of the project is to determine the effectiveness of specific brief counseling interventions in decreasing AIDS transmission risk behaviors.
