Resolution designating the Frederick T. and Eleanor Goll House, 1550 North Prospect Avenue, as an Historic Structure. (Historic Preservation Commission) This resolution designates the Frederick T. and Eleanor Goll House, 1550 North Prospect Avenue, as an Historic Structure. Whereas, The Milwaukee Historic Preservation Ordinance, Section 308-81 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, as amended, provides that Historic Sites, Structures and Districts may be designated by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee upon the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Commission; and

Whereas, The Historic Preservation Commission recommends that the Frederick T. and Eleanor Goll House, 1550 North Prospect Avenue, be designated as an Historical Structure; and

Whereas, This structure possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship and association and fulfills the following criterion set forth in Section 308 -81(2)(e):

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e-4. Portrays the environment of a group of people in an era of history characterized by a distinctive architectural style.

e-5. Its embodiment of the distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or specimen.

e-6. Its identification as the work of an artist, architect, interior designer, craftsperson or master builder whose individual works have influenced the development of the City of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin or of the United States.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the Frederick T. and Eleanor Goll House, 1550 North Prospect Avenue, and further described as follows:

be designated as a Milwaukee Historic Structure.
