Resolution authorizing payment of the judgment in the lawsuit entitled Oconomowoc Residential Programs, Inc., et al. v. City of Milwaukee, Case No. 97-C-251. (City Attorney)

This resolution authorizes the payment of the judgment in the lawsuit of Oconomowoc Residential Programs, Inc., et al. v. City of Milwaukee in the amount of \$590,912.81.

Whereas, Oconomowoc Residential Programs, Inc., Janet K. and Valerie D. have obtained a judgment against the City of Milwaukee in the amount of \$590,912.81 in a federal fair housing and disabilities act case arising out of the refusal to grant an accommodation under the City's ordinances relating to the spacing of community based residential facilities; and

Whereas, The City pursued an appeal of the trial court's judgment against the City, but the federal appeals court ruled in favor of the plaintiffs; and

Whereas, The City Attorney has concluded that a petition to the United States Supreme Court would not likely result in any reversal of the lower courts' decisions; and

Whereas, The City Attorney recommends and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee deems it expeditious and just to pay this judgment; now, therefore, be it
