Substitute resolution to settle claim of Russell Lepak for property loss.

Whereas, Members of the Judiciary and Legislation Committee have reviewed the records relating to the incident in which the claimant lost his tools, and have taken testimony from the claimant and City representatives. Based on this review, despite the recommendation of the City Attorney, members of the Committee believe it is most cost-effective to compromise and reduce the amount claimed from \$213.00 to \$110.00; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the proper city officers be and they hereby are authorized and directed to issue a city check in the total sum of \$110.00 payable to Russell Lepak, 5602 South 25th Street, Milwaukee, WI 53221, for partial reimbursement for loss of his tools; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the check is to be delivered upon presentation of a proper release, approved by the City Attorney; said amount to be charged to Account No. 636505, Fund - 0001, Organization - 1490, Program - 2631, Sub Class - S118. This resolution would release the City from any further liability arising from this incident.
