THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable.

After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

8th Aldermanic District

W. Canal St. - S. 30th St. to S. 44th St. (WT410031068): Water main extension. (Nonassessable Water Fund -- \$10,000)

9th Aldermanic District

N. 62nd St. - W. Mill Rd. to 700 feet m/l north of W. Mill Rd. (SW172030103): New sanitary sewer.

11th Aldermanic District

W. Leroy Ave. - S. 51st St. to S. 55th St. (WT410041078): Relaying water main. (Nonassessable Water Fund -- \$10,000)

; and, be it

Further Resolved, That all City Departments are authorized to perform engineering, surveys, plan preparation, and determine an estimated cost thereof; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
