Substitute resolution authorizing contracts for health maintenance organizations for 2004, fee-for-service dental plans for 2004-2005 and 2006 and flexible benefits program for 2004-2005 and 2006.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee Department of Employee Relations with Willis Corp. of Wisconsin and GBH, Inc. solicited responses to Requests for Proposals for Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs), Fee-for-Service Dental plans and Flexible Choices program providers; and

Whereas, A six-person team from the City of Milwaukee, including representatives from Department of Employee Relations (DER), City Clerk-Legislative Reference Bureau, Dept. of Administration-Budget & Management Division and Comptroller's Office reviewed the responses and associated costs for each of the three benefit programs; and

Whereas, The team and DER are now making recommendations regarding the three benefit programs; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the City of Milwaukee, that DER is authorized to enter into a contract with the CompicareBlue Health Services for their CompicareBlue Traditional HMO Network and their CompicareBlue Aurora Family HMO Network for HMO health services for City employees and retirees in 2004; and, be it

Further Resolved, That DER is authorized to enter into a contract with WPS and Delta Dental for prepaid dental services in 2004; and, be it

Further Resolved, That DER is authorized to enter into a contract with The Flex Company to administer the City's flexible benefits program for three years, 2004-2005 and 2006.
