SUBSTITUTE 1

ALD. WITKOWSKI AND BREIER

A substitute ordinance relating to limited use standards for certain uses in industrial zoning districts.

295-803-1 (table) am

295-803-2-L-4 am

295-803-2-v am

295-803-2-w am

This ordinance makes the following changes to the regulations for industrial zoning districts:

1. A mixed-waste processing facility or a heavy motor vehicle repair facility or body shop located within 150 feet of a residential zoning district shall be permitted as a limited use in an industrial-light (IL) or industrial-heavy (IH) zoning district only if the use is totally enclosed within a building and does

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not operate between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. (There are additional limited use standards for the 2 heavy motor vehicle-related uses). Currently, these uses are required to meet one of these standards, but not both, in order to be permitted as a limited use.

- 2. A material reclamation facility located within 150 feet of a residential district shall be permitted as a limited use in the industrial-heavy (IH) district only if the facility does not operate between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. (This is in addition to an existing limited use standard requiring the facility to be contained entirely within a building, regardless of the facility's distance from a residential district).
- 3. The classification of heavy motor vehicle outdoor storage in an industrial-light (IL) district is changed from limited use to special use. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 2. Section 295-803-2-L-4 of the code is amended to read:

295-803. Uses.

- 2. LIMITED USE STANDARDS.
- L. Heavy Motor Vehicle Repair Facility, Heavy Motor Vehicle Body Shop or Heavy Motor Vehicle Outdoor Storage.
- L-4. If the use is located within 150 feet of a residential district, it shall be totally enclosed >> $\underline{\text{within a building}} << [[\underline{\text{or}}]] >> \underline{\text{and}} <<$ it shall not operate between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Part 3. Section 295-803-2-v of the code is amended to read:
- v. Mixed-waste Processing Facility. If the use is located within 150 feet of a

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residential district $>>_{\underline{\prime}}<<$ it shall be totally enclosed $>>\underline{\text{within a building}}<<$ [[$\underline{\text{or}}$]] >>and<< it shall not operate between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Part 4. Section 295-803-2-w of the code is amended to read:

w. Material Reclamation Facility. The use shall be contained entirely within a building >> and, if located within 150 feet of a residential district, shall not operate between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. <<
