This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the Glasses for Kids Grant from the United Way of Greater Milwaukee in the amount of \$30,000. The purpose of the project is to provide vision screening, eye examinations and vision vouchers for eyeglasses for the Milwaukee school age population who do not have access to eye care and lack health insurance.
