THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

4th Aldermanic District

W. Everett St. - N. 2nd St. to N. 3rd St. (SM495040192): Relaying combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$5,000)

7th and 15th Aldermanic Districts

W. Locust St. - N. 29th St. to the Soo Line Railroad Right of Way (SM495020290): Relaying

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combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$5,000 additional funds)

Various Aldermanic Districts

Asphalt resurfacing of various streets by contract. (ST211050147)

Sealcoating of various streets by contract. (ST211050146)

Further Resolved, That all City Departments are authorized to perform engineering, surveys, plan preparation, and determine an estimated cost thereof; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
