Substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Childhood Immunization Disparities Grant.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the Childhood Immunization Disparities Grant project from the Centers for Disease Control in the amount of \$300,000 to reduce immunization disparities and increase immunization rates.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Centers for Disease Control to reduce immunization disparities and increase immunization rates; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 09/30/06 to 09/29/07 would cost \$300,000 provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Centers for Disease Control is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it

- 1. Expend from the amount appropriated sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Expend from the 2006 grant budget funds for training and out-of-town travel by departmental staff;
- 3. Enter into subcontracts and leases as detailed in the grant budget; and, be it
