The purpose of the project is to provide WIC clients with access to on-going reproductive health services.

Whereas, Common Council File #131106 authorized the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the 2014 Women, Infants and Children's Grant from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services. This grant provided for a Grantor share total of \$1,341,914; and

Whereas, The Grantor share for this program is increased by \$200,000; and

Whereas, it has been determined that activities of the WIC program will generate program income; and
