The purpose of the grant is to aid the Tuberculosis Control Clinic in its services to refugees.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the State of Wisconsin Division of Economic Support is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further

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approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2007 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Funds, the following amount for the project titled Refugee Health Screening:

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund - Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Grant Levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement; and, be it

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Expend from the 2007 grant budget funds for training and out-of-town travel by departmental staff;
- 3. Enter into leases and subcontracts as detailed in the grant budget; and
- 4. Expend from the 2007 grant funds for equipment as deemed necessary for program operation.
