ALD. KOVAC AND MURPHY

A substitute ordinance relating to the use of financial incentives to recruit students to enroll at city charter schools.

330-26 cr

This resolution prohibits a city-designated charter school from offering money or any other thing of pecuniary value to a parent, student, teacher, staff member or any other person as an incentive for recruiting a student.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 330-26 of the code is created to read:

330-26. Prohibited Practice. a. No charter school shall offer money or any other thing of pecuniary value to a parent, student, teacher, staff member or any other person as an incentive for recruiting a

student to enroll at a charter school.

b. The prohibition provided in par. a shall be included in the charter school contract and may result in the termination or revocation of the charter school contract as provided under s. 330-29.
