Whereas, Section 304-24 of the City of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances regulates the receipt, appropriation and expenditure of contributions received by the City, and

Whereas, The McDonald's Corporation has offered to provide \$2,500 to the Milwaukee Police Department to be spent on various community-related events held within Police District 7; now therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the City of Milwaukee Police Department is authorized to accept and expend \$2,500 from the McDonald's Corporation to be spent on various community-related events held within Police District 7; and, be it

Further Resolved, That upon receipt and deposit of these funds, the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to establish a special account within the budget for the expenditure of the contribution; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer appropriations and estimated revenue from the Contribution Fund-General, account number 0001-2110-D001-006300, and the Estimated Revenue account for contributions, account number 0001-2110-0001-009850 to the Police Department's Special Account 0001-3310-0001-DXXX-006300, and the Police Department's Estimated Revenue account 0001-3310-0001-009850 for the purposes set forth in this resolution in the amount of \$2,500.
