The sewer is being conveyed because it is no longer needed for public use.

Whereas, In 1976, the City of Milwaukee constructed an 15-inch diameter combined sewer in vacated East Madison Street from a point east of the east line of South 1st Street to vacated South Barclay Street; and

Whereas, Said East Madison Street was vacated on December 16, 2014 per Resolution No.141870; and

Whereas, The vacated lands are now part of Citizens Bank Mukwonago; and

Whereas, Due to the vacation of said portion of East Madison Street, the combined sewer no longer serves the public interest; and
