Substitute resolution relative to legislative bills.

Whereas, The Judiciary and Legislation Committee of the Common Council has recommended the following positions on the bills hereinafter listed and the Common Council being advised of said matters; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it hereby approves the following legislative bills and instructs the Division of Intergovernmental Relations to appear before the proper committees to support such bilsl and use its best endeavors to have the same enacted into law, viz:

LRB-1325/1 Relating to: prohibiting certain schedule V controlled substances from being dispensed without a prescription.

LRB-1328/1 Relating to: Prevention and control of, emergency and involuntary commitment for, and treatment programs and services for drug dependence.

LRB-0639/1 Relating to: authorizing the director of the Office of Educational Opportunity in the University of Wisconsin System to contract for the operation of a recovery school, insurance coverage of mental health treatment provide by a recovery charter school, and making appropriations.
