THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City engineering cost estimated to be \$64,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$689,000.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable. After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council. The City cost for engineering these projects is estimated to be \$64,000 with the total cost estimated to be \$689,000.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

3rd Aldermanic District

N. Humboldt Blvd. at E. Center St. (ST211160177): Install pedestrian access ramps. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$1,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$16,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

4th Aldermanic District

W. Wells St. - N. 6th St. to N. 8th St. (SM495160055): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable

Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$252,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

4th and 15th Aldermanic Districts

N. 35th St. - W. State St. to W. Highland Blvd. (SM495160059): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$12,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$94,000 . This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

7th Aldermanic District

W. Ely Pl./N. 54th St. - W. Fond du Lac Ave. to W. Congress St. (SM495160058): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$10,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$60,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

14th Aldermanic District

S. Wentworth Ave. - E. Texas Ave. to E. Oklahoma Ave. (SM495160057): Combined sewer lining. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$10,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$48,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

15th Aldermanic District

W. Albany Pl. - N. 13th St. to N. Teutonia Ave. (SM495160056): Relaying combined sewer. (Nonassessable Sewer Maintenance Relay Fund -- \$15,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$189,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

North Avenue Bioswale - SDC Parking Lot, 1701 W. North Ave. (SM499160116): (Storm Water Quality - Nonassessable Water Quality Projects to meet TMDL Requirements -- \$1,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$30,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

Further Resolved, That all City Departments are authorized to perform engineering, surveys, plan preparation, and determine an estimated cost thereof; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
