Resolution authorizing the installation of a new traffic control signal at the intersection of East Cherry Street and North Water Street in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

This resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to install a new traffic control signal at the intersection of East Cherry Street and North Water Street with funding from the Department of Public Works capital fund at an estimated cost of \$75,000.

Whereas, The traffic volumes at the intersection of East Cherry Street and North Water Street exceed federal warrants in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for the installation of a traffic control signal; and

Whereas, The installation of a traffic control signal at the intersection of East Cherry Street and North Water Street will provide for a better exchange of right-of-way over the existing stop control; and

Whereas, The estimated cost of the installation of a traffic control signal is \$75,000, and is included in the Department of Public Works traffic signal capital fund approved under Common Council File Number 151122; and

Whereas, The installation of a traffic control signal at East Cherry Street and North Water Street is scheduled for summer 2016; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the Commissioner of Public Works is authorized to install a new traffic control signal at the intersection of East Cherry Street and North Water Street using funding from the Department of Public Works capital fund.
