The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 1 of ordinance File Number 150505 relative to offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 25, 2016 - November 20, 2016):

Under City Attorney's Office, Administrative Division," delete one position of "Legal Office Assistant", and under the "Docket Unit" add one position of "Docketing Specialist - Senior."

Part 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Part 3. The provisions of Part 1 of this ordinance are deemed to be in force and effect from and after Pay Period 25, 2016 (November 20, 2016).

The provisions of all other parts of this ordinance are deemed to be in force and effect from and after the first day of the first pay period following passage and publication.

Part 4. This ordinance will take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
