THE CHAIR

Resolution establishing the 2017 Snow and Ice Removal Cost Recovery Charge.

In accordance with s. 309-83 of the Code of Ordinances, this resolution establishes the 2017 Snow and Ice Removal Cost Recovery Charge at \$0.943 per foot of street frontage, an increase of 3% from the \$0.9155 rate in 2016. For residential property owners with multiple street frontage (corner lots), the City will use the shortest side to calculate the charge. For non-residential property owners, the City will use total street frontage.

Whereas, Section 309-83 of the Code of Ordinances establishes a Snow and Ice Removal Cost Recovery Charge as authorized by s. 66.0627, Wis. Stats.; and

Whereas, Section 309-83 of the Code requires adoption of a resolution on an annual basis that establishes the snow and ice removal cost recovery charge; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the 2017 annual snow and ice removal cost recovery charge, to be billed on a yearly basis, is established as follows:

1. Residential property: \$0.943 per foot of street frontage. For residential property (one-, 2-, 3-, and 4-family dwelling units) with multiple street frontage (corner lots), the shortest side shall be used for billing purposes.
2. Nonresidential property: \$0.943 per foot of total street frontage.

Further Resolved, That this resolution takes effect January 1, 2017.
